Lead by the Board of Trustees, we began to explore new flooring options. After many samples, reviews, discussions and quotes, they decided on a medium woodgrain finish LVT flooring option. This choice was made based on the quality, longevity, ease of maintenance and pricing of the material.

Our Church Committee approved the project and the Finance Committee started a fund-raising campaign. Our devoted and loving church family stepped up and donated the money to replace the flooring. We are truly blessed to have disciples that have a vision to make improvements at the church.

In the process of upgrading the flooring, we were gifted with 100 matching chairs and 12 tables to complete the overall transformation of our Fellowship Hall. The work was completed and unveiled to full congregation on Sunday, January 18th.
